Saskatoon Zoom Boom Ticket - Zoom Boom Training focuses on correctly training prospective operators on variable reach forklifts. The training objectives consist of gaining the knowledge of the machine's physics and to define the job of the operator. This program adheres to North American safety standards for lift trucks. Zoom boom training and certification is available at the company's location or at our site, provided there are a few trainees. Certification given upon successfully completing it is valid for three years.

The telehandler or likewise known as a telescopic handler is similar in various ways to a common forklift or a crane. This versatile machine is made together with a telescopic boom which could extend forward and lift upwards. Different attachments could be fitted on the end of the boom, like bucket, pallet forks, lift table or muck grab. It is popular in industry and agriculture settings.

The telehandler is a common used along with fork attachments to allow the transporting of loads. Telehandlers have the advantage of being able to reach those inaccessible places which can't be reached by a common forklift. Telehandlers can remove loads that are palletized from inside a trailer and placing them on high places such as rooftops. For certain applications, they can be more efficient and practical as opposed to a crane.

The disadvantage of the telehandler is its instability when lifting heavier loads. When the boom extends with a load, the unit becomes more and more unsteady. Counterweights in the rear help, but do not solve the problem. As the working radius increases, the lifting capacity rapidly decreases. Various machinery come with front outriggers that extend the lifting capacity while the machinery is stationary.
