General Hazards

Common kinds of hazard in a warehouse environment are slips, trips and falls. These accidents are usually caused when staff lose their balance or stumble over something that has not been put away properly. Placing or removing items from storage can result in a slip or fumble, potentially causing both item and worker to fall. The potential for slips, trips and falls is increased when employees are moving things on various kinds of floor surfaces and on various levels. One more common hazard is getting hit by falling stuff. This is normally caused by failure to properly stack stuff on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries due to incorrect lifting methods are one more common hazard.

Warehouse machines carries inherent dangers. Injuries or accidents could be caused by hand trucks, forklift trucks and conveyors if they are not operated right. Warehouse tools, such as pallets, skids, cutting and strapping tools, should be utilized carefully in packing, unpacking and loading.

Hazardous substances, combustible or flammable materials could pose danger while being stored inside a warehouse. Employees should know how to take steps to protect themselves from health hazards when working around dangerous materials.
